Driving Directions

Driving from North of UC San Diego:

Take I-5 South

Exit Genesee Ave.

Make a left on Genesee Ave.

Make a right at Campus Point Drive (3rd stop light)

Make a right at Voigt Drive (1st stop light)

Make a right at the second stop sign (stop sign #10). This is still Voigt Drive.

Make a right at the third stop sign (stop sign #13) into Parking Lot P502 – Check-in Station #1

Driving from South of UC San Diego:

Take I-5 North

Exit Genesee Ave.

Make a right on Genesee Ave.

Make a right at Campus Point Drive (3rd stop light)

Make a right at Voigt Drive (1st stop light)

Make a right at the second stop sign (stop sign #10). This is still Voigt Drive.

Make a right at the third stop sign (stop sign #13) into Parking Lot P502 – Check-in Station #1

There will be signs to direct you along the way. All Warren residents must first check-in at check-in station #1 (Parking Lot P502) with the Qwik-Pass visibly displayed on the driver's side dashboard. This is the ONLY check-in point for Warren Move-In. Other college move-ins and events will be going on during this time, so please use this route to avoid any confusion. Our office will be unable to answer phone calls on Saturday, September 27 and Sunday, September 28 due to move-in. Please plan accordingly.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. I will be bringing more than one vehicle. Where can I unload this vehicle? Only one vehicle per student will be permitted at check-in station #1 (Parking Lot P502). Any other vehicles will be directed to park in the Hopkins parking structure. You can unload this vehicle after 7:00pm.
- 2. What if I'm arriving in a taxi? Students who plan to arrive by taxi must email the Residential Life Office at warrenreslife@ucsd.edu no later than **Friday, September 19 at 12:00pm**. Students arriving via taxi will NOT participate in the guided move-in process but may still check in at their assigned time. Students who have made prior arrangements should proceed directly to the corner of Equality Lane (stop sign #12). Please call the office at 858-534-4581 if you need additional directions. Our office will be unable to answer phone calls on Saturday, September 27 and Sunday, September 28 due to move-in. Please plan accordingly.
- 3. I missed my assigned move- in time. What do I do now? If you missed your assigned move-in time, do not worry. You will still be able to move your belongings in, just at a later time. The best option would be to go and get some food off-campus and relax. Students may want to purchase their parking permits, get their Student ID card (first-year students), or buy/pick up their books at the bookstore if time allows.

For those who missed their assigned time, the Warren College Student Activity Center (SAC) will be open from 7:00pm-10:00pm for students to check in and pick up their keys. The guided move-in process will have concluded by this time, although signs will still be posted throughout the complex. You may check out a blue bin (a \$5.00 deposit and valid driver's license or state-issued ID is required for rental) to assist in moving your belongings. Please note that there are a limited number of blue bins available and the last rental time is at 9:00pm. We <u>highly recommend</u> that you bring a dolly/hand truck to transport your belongings from the parking lot to your room. Vehicles parked illegally (on sidewalks, in cul-de-sacs, in reserved spaces, etc.) may be cited.

4. I am unable to move-in on Saturday, September 27 and September 28. What are my other options?

All residents must pick up their keys no later than <u>4:00pm on Tuesday</u>, <u>September 30, 2014</u>. Contact us in writing via email at <u>warrenreslife@ucsd.edu</u> by noon on Friday, September 29, 2014 to notify our office if you will be arriving late.

5. Where is the closest handicapped parking at Warren College?
Students who will require handicapped parking must email the Residential Life Office at warrenreslife@ucsd.edu no later than Friday, September 19 at 12:00pm. There are a few handicapped spaces located in the Justice Lane cul-de-sac.
