## Dates and Deadlines

July 1: Deadline for transcripts. If you have outstanding transcripts, request to have them sent immediately to the UC San Diego Office of Admissions.

July 7: Complete your Academic Background on the New Student Site at [newstudent.ucsd.edu](http://newstudent.ucsd.edu)

July 15: Submit final test scores for ACT/SAT/AP/IB/TOEFL to the UC San Diego Office of Admissions

## Math Testing and Placement

### **Student Health Services Deadline**

You must complete the Tuberculosis (TB) Screening Questionnaire on [MyApplication](#) before **July 15**. If the screening is not completed, a hold will be placed on your account preventing you from registering for Fall Quarter classes.
