
8. Director of Student Organizations - Alex Chen Nothing to report.

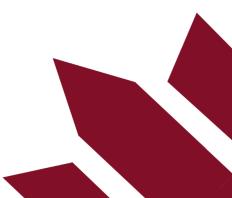
