Two-Pass Enrollment Process

Enrollment occurs every quarter for the following quarter. It's done in two-passes to ensure students have a chance to enroll in their pre-major, major, and GE courses. Enrollment times are found through the <u>TritonLink</u> by logging in to <u>WebReg</u>.

FIRST PASS

- Students can enroll in up to 11.5 units
- Waitlists are not available
- First pass lasts for 48 hours
- If students don't enroll during their first pass appointment, they must wait until their second pass appointment to enroll

SECOND PASS

- Students can enroll in up to 19.5 units
- Waitlists are available

FIRST DAY OF CLASSES

- Students can enroll in up to 22.0 units
- If you'd like to enroll in more than 22.0 units for the quarter, send in an EASy request

 System under "Classes and Enrollment
 tools"

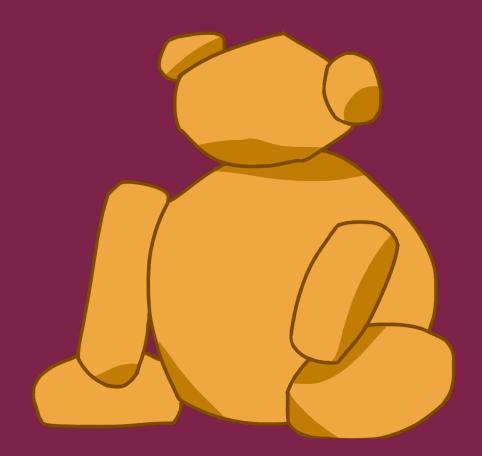
