


- f. Events Board Chair Tatiana Valdovinos

 - a. "Basics of Event Planning" by Events Board Chair Tatiana Valdovinos
 - i. Basics of Event Planning- Eboard 24-25
 - 1. Also student affairs intern. Did welcome week events. So she feels like she has good experience. Phase of brainstorming. Why are you hosting this event? What is the purpose of this event? How does this event fit into your mission statement/goals? Budget? If your organization does not have a budget, you can ask the council. Prioritize bigger events versus smaller events. Keep your advisors in the loop and think about your audience. Logistics: who, what, when and where? Advertise it to the students you are advertising to. Where? Research space. Room reservation calendar. Fill it out with time and give them time to respond to you. EPP Form. What is it?





The event planning and proposal form. Outlines the event timeline. Suggested timeline: 3 weeks. Especially for bigger events: 6-8 weeks in advance. Who can help you? Your advisors, or Tatiana. If you are planning a bigger event, we can ask other resources on campus such as ResLife. Typically we order things to come to the office so it goes to the mailroom and then the office. How much time do you need for setup and cleanup. For example, if you need the room for the event from 5:00 PM - 7:00 PM, reserve the room from 3:00 PM - 7:00 PM or maybe even later so you can clean up. Take things into consideration. If something did not work. Talk about it during debrief, why did it not work, how can it be improved? Surveys is a good idea to get student feedback.


 Rules Committee Revisions Results (10/28/2024)
- 8. Open Forum
 - a. Provost Visit
 - Marisa Abrohano. Provost at Warren College. Welcome to Warren Council.
 Wanted to talk about two things.
 - Resolution regarding the renaming of Black Hall. Chancoller appreciated the idea of renaming. Decision that he made was to put a poster to talk about the history of Black for residents and everyone else to see. There is a new policy where they will not name





things after people. Guidelines were decided by HDH. She is in charge of working on the changes.

- a. Renaming of black hall he made the decisions to create signage or a plague. Recent guidelines and policies for buildings, things are no longer named after people. Whoever wants to help with the signage can talk to aries to help. Language is important. If we start now hopefully by the end of the academic year we can make the signage happen.
 - i. Skyler said it may be small so that no one sees it.
 Either have multiple ones or to have one in the center so it is more significant.
 - ii. Provost agrees, there can be multiple conversations about it. Incorporate it in the college's history.
 Educate people during orientation in the beginning.
 Talk about who they are and talk about them so they can understand them.
 - iii. William: Did they talk about who would be funding the signage
 - iv. Provost: it is not decided
 - v. Elijah: disagrees on similarities between Warren and Hugo black. Left the KKK to get his position and rejoined afterwards.

 - viii. Provost: Her take is that it was an option. If it was something that the council could not accept, then that should not have been put in the resolution.






- ix. Aries: Offered on our end and if we were not interested in that option it should not have been included.

 - 1. Haley: Senior analyst works in undergrad education. Had been at







- 3. On campus, this would refer to the programs that would lead to a bachelor degree. It includes your programs, classes, advising, etc to enhance your growth. Her office oversees all of the college provosts. They meet with advisors and student affairs. Work with OSD office, academic integrity, and other offices. Teaching Learning Commons and Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs.
- 4. The plan: the mission statement is: to advance an undergraduate student experience grounded in a liberal arts education within a world class public university. They have a form and want feedback on the mission and vision statement.

 - iii. Establish expectations around acuity-student






- interactions and student support in the classroom

They don't list all of the staff members on the website. Ratio of student to faculty. Highlighting how they use student feedback to make changes. y y offer. They say they can offer something but then say that they cannot actually offer that.

- 17. Haley: You can send it to me.
- 18. Aries: increased number of undergraduate students. Doesn't serve the undergraduate students. So many people have less resources to help them all.
