

 - ii. Panda express has a door to right of it that leads to the room. It is a long banana shaped room and has been used for a long time. They had a few ideas and one of which was going to be very expensive. UCSD is committed to at least returning 70 percent to the land field and the problem is that only 30 percent is recycled right now. For example in Panda Express, there are 18 pieces that need to be separated into three different bins. The one that takes food waste and is contaminated with a piece of plastic, it would all be thrown away. They were planning on getting new utensils and the only space available is the banana shaped room. It takes a long time to separate the trash and this project is estimated to cost around 1 million dollars. Currently it is not really possible as there is not one million dollars to spend on that. Another idea is to turn it into a comic store. Back in 2008 it was a popular space for clubs and it can be used for that. Food, general, and bookstore Co-op was signed for another four years. Possible cut off budgets in the figure.




- Fourth year, major in global health and minor in political science. During the first year, learned a lot about recreation and knew about the new changes happening.




