  - a. Special Presentation on 23-24 Budget by Advisor Brecht
  - b. Context: we will vote on budget week 9
  - c. Thought it would be helpful to go over it now before we vote
  - d. Budget comes from student fees
    - i. How much do we pay?
    - ii. \$9.05 originally, fees went up to \$10.41
    - iii. Take student fee, per Warren student, per quarter
    - iv. How much money per year
    - v. We get \$30 from every student per year
    - vi. A lot of estimates
    - vii. We estimate around 4700 students
    - viii. Some portion must be returned to financial aid
      - 1. Take numbers and subtract that amount to get our total budget
      - 2. We usually round or go to lower end if we have to estimate
      - 3. Take amount and allocate based on percentages that we vote on
    - ix. Next week we'll be voting on these percentages
    - x. Further explanation to come from our Financial Director Mariah
    - xi. Advisors work with different orgs





- xii. A little confusing
- xiii. Questions
  - 1. How often does this change?
  - 2. Yearly finance chair presents to council in fall
  - 3. Vote on budget in Spring now
  - 4. Percentages change a little
  - Amount that is given back to reserves (if you go over budget) never changes
  - 6. Pretty consistent but does fluctuate
  - 7. Is there a difference between Council Internal and General Unallocated?
  - 8. Internal is about internal council things (retreat, merch, etc.)
  - 9. General Unallocated is for what we can put towards events etc.
  - 10. Track expenses through years
  - 11. Ours goes faster than central campus reporting
- xiv. General Unallocated
  - 1. Example: We funded Lunar New Year event
  - 2. We track spending
  - 3. If you want representatives to give concrete updates, you can
  - 4. WTCC is preallocated
  - 5. If you have remaining percentage at the end, it goes back to us in a fund (Reserves & carry forward)
- xv. Estimate of how much is in reserves
  - 1. Around \$110,000
  - 2. In 2020, council voted to return Spring fees to students
  - 3. We gave back \$30K
  - 4. It was a long process, but we have the power to give money back to the students
  - 5. Reserves is great for longer lasting things, more than just one year
  - 6. We can use it for current students
- xvi. This presentation is in Slack for your reference
- xvii. We also get money from AS, around \$10 K
  - 1. Often put this money back into Reserves

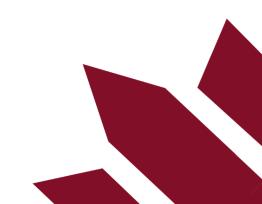




- xviii. Used as running total
- xix. Each year budget is reapproved so it could change or be re-edited later
- xx. This allows us to know how much money we are working with
- xxi. Open communication is able to flow because the organization representatives come to council meetings
- xxii. What is the process of adding a new category?
  - 1. New category will be proposed soon
  - 2. Nothing that says it has to be written the way that it is
- xxiii. If we add things, do they have to be written into the bylaws?
  - 1. Depends on what the language says
- xxiv. Miscellaneous can be used for things that do not fall under A-G
- xxv. Who does the taxes?/Is any of it taxable?
  - 1. Tax would be included in the total
    - a. If you wanted to take \$300 for a Canes event, taxes would need to be covered by that \$300

#### 8. Open Forum

- Input for changes being made to the upcoming 24-25 year budget. By Director Arteaga
- b. Changes that we'd like to make
- c. Council Internal percentage would stay the same
- d. Warren Special Events has 4%
  - i. Diplomas took up a lot, we decreased by half a percentage
  - ii. Additionally, we have our 50th anniversary
- e. WTCC stayed the same
- f. WCFC changed from 25% to 28%
  - i. Make room for different organizations and events
- g. COWS based on input from residents based on Spirit Week
  - Increasing so that things are more fun and increase spirit on campus from 4% to 8%
- h. Warren GROW decreased to half a percentage
  - i. They do not attend council nor do they use all of their funds
  - ii. They currently use around \$200 of the \$600 allocated to them
- i. Council Reserves changed from 5% to 3% to be consistent with the bylaws





- i. Questions/Concerns:
  - i. General Unallocated, we got rid of some positions but should we look into increasing it?
  - ii. WCFC has a lot of money left over
    - 1. Based on position and what people are doing, it could differ
  - iii. We'll vote on percentage changes next week
    - 1. Total amounts included for an estimated reference
  - iv. Diploma cover was assumed to come out of Warren Special Events or General Unallocated?
    - 1. Probably would be called Miscellaneous
    - 2. Or we could get rid of Miscellaneous category and have it be General Unallocated
  - v. E-boards, is there an estimate for how much is needed?
    - 1. No estimate because we allocate around \$20K for semi-formal every year
    - 2. This year we didn't use everything we allocated for like we often do
  - vi. Some years things fluctuate based on engagement
    - 1. This is why participation in orgs is important
    - 2. Example: HDH catering, prices fluctuate
    - 3. Semi-formal was off-campus in previous years
    - 4. WTCC does Disneyland trip so big portion of budget goes to tickets and buses
  - vii. William says we should add more to Unallocated since we have \$20K left
    - Having low numbers disincentivizes people from events or side projects
  - viii. How does WTCC work?
    - 1. Disney event
    - 2. They sell tickets
    - 3. Way for Transfers and Commuters to connect so they get priority
    - 4. This year it's more expensive
      - a. Also because it is on a Saturday and Memorial Day is coming up
      - b. Trying to collab with other colleges but some colleges didn't





- say anything or waited until a week before
- c. Some students didn't make it so bus waiting time had to be extended
- d. Used to leave before fire works but changed it because it is stressful and hard to get off of Disney
- e. Extended until 11 PM
- 5. Students' tickets are subsidized along with the staff tickets
- 6. We could possibly pull from Reserves next year
  - a. Special request process
  - b. We'd have to vote on it
  - c. Might be separate from this budget
- ix. Katy will add another tab to the budget to further outline this
- x. We ran out of money this year
  - 1. Some RAs didn't know that they could come to council for money
  - 2. As long as they follow guidelines, it is quite similar to them holding events
  - 3. Easier to request money if you are in council because we are here every week
  - 4. Skyler also suggests lowering percentages so that we can give more to General Unallocated
    - a. If we had less in the other categories it might be help
- xi. No one was as mad that we ran out of money for council than Paxton -self proclaimed
- xii. Aries moved to extend the presentation to 30 minutes (rather than twenty)
  - 1. Skyler seconded
  - 2. No one was in opposition
- xiii. Paxton: kudos to Mariah for organization of the budget
- xiv. Paxton disagrees with adding more to General Unallocated funds
- xv. People need to spend their funds this year and if it ends up in General Unallocated it might not get spent
- xvi. Thinks that the amount it has been raised to is good
- xvii. Not much harm if we have money left over in General Unallocated because it will go to Reserves like with other categories





- xviii. Prior to 2023-2024, how close have we gotten to using up the budget
  - 1. We used to allocate around 11% and didn't use much
  - 2. Dependent on people making requests
  - 3. For 2021-2022, used almost all
  - 4. For 2022-2023, had around \$9K left
- xix. Kate says we should emphasis to council that E-board funds can be used next year so that funding doesn't come from General Unallocated
  - 1. We don't have to increase the budget for this category
- xx. Paxton says, it's good for us to save money, generate new ideas
  - Next Up slate was pushing for more intercollege events so money doesn't have to come from just Warren but could come from other colleges to support
- xxi. William, if we had higher percentage for Unallocated funds, we would've used it
  - 1. Simple to request funding from Unallocated
  - Suppose it was way higher, than if other sectors needed money they could request it from Unallocated and get closer to having \$0 remaining
  - 3. We can get closer to \$0 here versus if more was given to E-board
- xxii. Paxton, point of information
  - 1. Where do you propose we get the rest of the money from?
  - 2. E-board has used most of the money that is allocated in past years
  - 3. By statistics, E-boards hasn't been used
  - 4. Might be extreme to go to 20
- xxiii. William, used as an example not a literal reasoning on the exact amount
- xxiv. Skyler, student fees are higher than they've ever been
  - 1. Looking at the others, we can decide to have money close to this year's and give more money to General Unallocated
  - 2. Only 4800 goes into a new section
  - 3. Thinks we could lower budget from 8% that was proposed to 7%
  - 4. Value might come out to the same as last year
  - 5. Small events get people to go out
  - 6. Different interests and people
