 - ii. DISCUSSION: "Removal of Open Roll Call Vote" sponsored by President Cole





- 1. Skyler
 - a. As stated before, we have talked about this before
 - b. Agrees that open roll call, de-incentivizes people from coming
- 2. Paxton
 - a. Disagrees
 - b. Open roll call, meant to deter us not meeting quorum
 - i. Useful tool
 - c. Understands that it could suggest reasons for not being here
 - i. We have 6 absences rule
 - d. Useful when people who don't care about council don't show up
- 3. Aries
 - a. Never been an instance where we haven't met quorum
- 4. William
 - a. If you're not coming to meetings, doesn't make sense that you can vote on decisions you don't know much about
 - b. Could allow for mischievous things to happen
 - i. Could swing things in your favor
 - ii. Could misuse things
- 5. Ariel
 - a. Think that we have rules in place for people who are interested in coming to council
 - b. Important to still hear what council has to say
 - c. We need 3/4 for constitutional bylaws
 - i. This was an issue previously
 - d. This allowed us to still get work done
- 6. Skyler
 - At the same time, if you miss a meeting, offering an extra couple days not great that people are voting and not knowing what they are voting on
 - b. Not updated
 - c. Not asking questions





- d. Not putting in initiative to educate themselves, in their own beliefs and opinions
- e. Reiterates that it is unnecessary and could cause more issues

7. Paxton

- Despite people going with what their friends want, the fact of them being out of council removes them from heard voting
- b. Open roll call vote allows this to be a positive thing
 - i. Especially for people who aren't as motivated to vote

8. William


- a. Changed his opinion

9. Skyler

- a. Another concern: we have something in place now and we've seen that it works
 - i. Resignation by non-attendance,
 - ii. 6 consecutive meetings
 - iii. They could miss 5 and show up for 1
 - We can obviously go through the impeachment process
 - 2. Not something any of us want to do to anyone

3. Crossroads

- Difficult to say that they would be impeached or just resign by non-attendance because they probably won't
- b. A lot of easy things like open roll-call





vote could allow people to just abstain, which is still a good thing, but they could easily just say yes or no

- 10. Paxton yields time to Mr. Chen
 - a. People might just vote on what they know about things
 - b. Has voted on things he doesn't know about before
 - c. Made a mistake because he thought students wanted something but didn't really know what students wanted
 - i. Now HDH has taken over Audrey's
 - ii. Yields back to Paxton

11. Paxton

- a. Was allowed his vote at the beginning of the year
- b. Everyone who was just joining had a counting vote even though they didn't know what they were voting for
 - i. Legislation still passed
- c. This isn't the greatest deterrent to uneducated votes
- d. Yields time to the floor

12. Elijah

- a. Doesn't think that the idea that people can join council and just give their friends votes is well-founded
- b. He hasn't seen this in his 2 quarters here
- c. We have bylaws in place to remove people
 - Notes that he should've been removed in Fall Quarter but he wasn't

- e. People probably aren't reading the minutes anyways
- f. You have a voice but they don't know what they are voting on so why would they take time vote

 - b. Something Tatiana wants to continue







 - viii. Can partner with Triton Pantry


3. Mo


- i. Are you committed to coming to meetings? You handle a huge percentage of our budget

- ii. Has heard that the event didn't represent Dia de los Muertos well






- iii. They didn't attend, but not because they don't attend events but because it didn't represent them

f. Mo


- For transfer events, in transfer lounge, the last event on finding apartments

foot forward


- d. Having no hair can limit the amount of things that are needed to be thought about

 - iv. In the beginning it might be a mess but at the end it will be cool


